### About this piece

By an unidentified British glasshouse, a **pair of acid-etched glass shades** aligned to the **Victorian period (1837–1901), c.1890**. One is a **cranberry flashed** globe shade acid-etched with a floral ground; the other an **opal satin** tulip with a **crimped rim**, both blown with **ground fitter collars** for period galleries.

Dimensions (opal tulip): Height 17.8 cm (7 in) | Diameter 11.4 cm (4.5 in)
