### About this piece

This **pair of Arts and Crafts brass candlesticks** was produced around 1900 and reflects the simplicity and discipline of British domestic metalwork during the *Arts and Crafts movement* (1880–1910). Each candlestick is constructed in six assembled sections with reeded fluting to the column and a stepped circular base.

The design expresses *British vernacular craftsmanship*, where proportion and structural logic took precedence over applied ornament. Brass was favoured for its warm tone and malleability, allowing hand-finishing and assembly in workshops influenced by the ideals of Morris and Ashbee.
