### About this piece

This **pair of mottled yellow and orange glass shades** was produced around 1930 during the later phase of the *Arts and Crafts movement* 1880–1910 and its lingering influence through the interwar period. Each hand-blown shade features a warm palette of marbled orange and yellow glass, the colours fusing within a softly flared bell form.

The mottled surface was achieved through the introduction of coloured frits into molten glass, producing a spontaneous painterly effect admired for its natural variation. Such shades were often fitted to pendant or wall lights, bringing vibrancy and warmth to domestic interiors at a time when artisanal methods continued to coexist with early industrial glass production.
