About this piece

Glasgow School oak hallstand produced around **c.1905**, representing the mature phase of the *Arts and Crafts Movement* (1880–1910) as expressed through the restrained geometry of Glasgow design. The piece exemplifies the union of practicality and architectural form central to the movement's domestic furnishings.

Constructed in **solid oak**, the tall frame is defined by an arched mirror over a shallow central shelf, supported by open side panels composed of vertical slats that curve elegantly toward the base. The upper section is fitted with **hand-forged iron coat hooks**, their subtle scrollwork providing a sculptural counterpoint to the linear frame.
