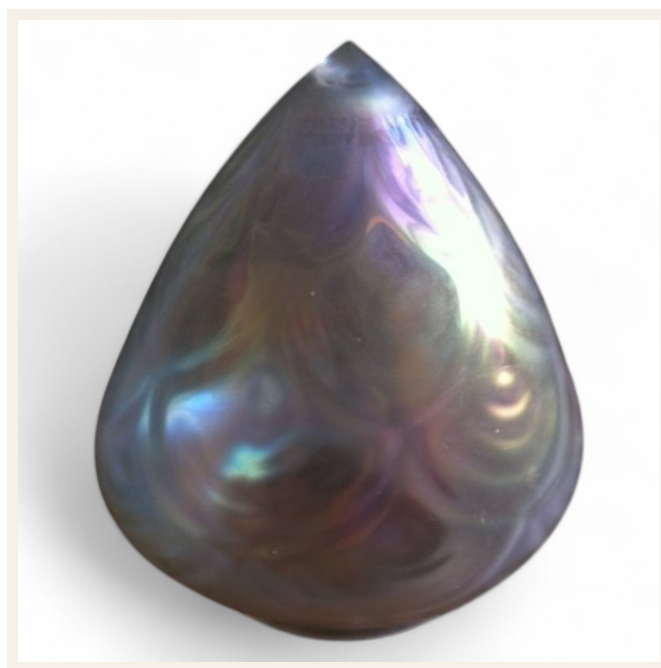

### About this piece

The **shade** in **opaque glass** belongs to the *Arts and Crafts* (1880–1910) tradition, **c.1900**. Formed as a teardrop or pineapple, the body carries a subtle tinted lustre that reads with iridescent highlights across the softly lobed surface. A rolled fitter rim finishes the top opening, the profile suited to ceiling galleries or pendant conversions, giving an even, mellow diffusion.
