About this piece

By **Edward Barnsley**, a **walnut stool** aligned to the *Arts and Crafts* movement (1880–1910), **c.1920**, within the Cotswold School tradition. The rectangular frame has gently arched aprons and slim legs that taper to the floor, a spare profile that favours line and proportion over applied ornament. The seat retains its original tapestry; the underside is stamped **Barnsley**. The combination of careful hand shaping, clean junctions and restrained curvature is characteristic of early twentieth-century Cotswold work from the Barnsley circle, marrying utility with finely judged craft.
