About this piece

An **EPNS punch bowl** with **matching ladle** on a **scroll wire stand**, aligned to late *Arts and Crafts* taste, **c.1925–1935**. The spun copper bowl is silver-plated and fitted with **three small cast “shell” pads** that seat it on the stand's top ring. The detachable stand is formed from brazed wire with swept scrolls, and the ladle has a **twisted stem** and playful **loop finial**. The light wirework, EPNS construction and shell seating pads are characteristic of **British interwar entertaining ware** from the Sheffield/Birmingham trade.

Unmarked. Construction (spun EPNS bowl, brazed wire stand, shell pads, twisted-stem ladle) is consistent with **British interwar** production. Absence of German WMF ostrich or big Sheffield house stamps suggests a **smaller UK workshop** rather than a major branded firm.
