About this piece

A set of four lengths of Georgian hand-wrought iron railings

with hoop-style tops and circular hand-formed end finials to each section.

They are made from wrought iron, so they are extremely strong and much stronger than cast iron. Wrought iron requires little maintenance and defends against rust and corrosion very well, unlike cast iron, so they could be left as they are to preserve their original look.

The end upright flat bars are heavy gauge and perfect for fixing to a wall or a post. There is a top, middle, and bottom heavy gauge horizontal flat bar which joins to the end uprights and holds the round bars and everything in place.

To each corner end at the base, there are small lugs, which could be slotted into the floor. The lower flat bar can then be screwed and fixed to the ground, as well as the side uprights — which would make it invincible.

 - Thickness of post: 1.25"
- Middle left railing
 - Post height: 36"
 - Length: 81"
 - Thickness of post: 1"
- Middle right railing
 - Post height: 37.5"
 - Length: 81"
 - Thickness of post: 1"
- Far right railing
 - Post height: 38"
 - Length: 92"
 - Thickness of post: 1.25"

Total length: 330" or 27 feet 6 inches
