### About this piece

#### Liberty & Co.

A rare and unusual Moorish oval eight leg side table with a brass removable top embossed with a medieval lioness holding a sword while her cub feeds from her.

With eight arched fretwork panels running around the upper section, the fine turned legs unite the lower shelf raised Moucharabieh turnings within a gallery running around the sides.

The legs have a double raised turned detail below and above the lower shelf, a subtle detail taking them to elegant slender sabre feet.
