About this piece

A **hammered pewter and enamel photograph frame** attributed to **Liberty & Co.**, *Arts and Crafts movement*, rectangular form with inset roundel, c.1900.

This **hammered pewter photograph frame**, attributed to **Liberty & Co.** and dating to around **c.1900**, embodies the *Arts and Crafts movement's* preference for textured metalwork and handcrafted ornament. The rectangular surround is hammered throughout, inset at the crest with a circular enamel roundel in green tones.

Such frames were characteristic of Liberty's *Cymric* and *Tudric* ranges, produced in pewter with restrained colour accents to harmonise with domestic interiors. The backboard remains intact, and the metal retains a consistent patina commensurate with age

and handling. The piece reflects the firm's interest in fusing artistic design with functional craftsmanship.
