### About this piece

By William Birch for **Liberty and Co**, a **walnut side chair** designed by **E. G. Punnett**, aligned to the *Arts and Crafts* movement (1880–1910), **c.1901**. The tall rectangular back has a narrow top rail set with two circular floral medallion inlays in contrasting sycamore and boxwood, divided by square apertures, above an open three-bar panel. A trapezoidal upholstered seat with grape-and-leaf patterned textile sits on round legs with twin side stretchers and a single front and rear stretcher.
