A set of Anglo-Japanese cast iron fire insert

Which shows strong design similarities between **Thomas Jeckyll's** work for **Barnard Bishop & Barnard** and **E. W. Godwin** for **S S** and **Shorland Manchester** under the cape of **Ernest Hooper**, circa 1880s.

Both slightly different sizes - approx. 2" difference all round. Left: Height 36", width 22", depth: 2", height of opening 24 1/2", width of opening 19".

Right: Height 36", width 18", depth: 2", height of opening 24 1/2", width of opening 15". I also have one more in stock the same but a different size. Price shown is for one insert, the smaller one.
