A pair of Anglo-Japanese side tables inset with **Barnard Bishop & Barnard** sunflower tiles. With ring turned simulating bamboo legs and an unusual fifth central turned leg supporting the three staggered shelves. The three central turned tops are in unison with further turned finials to the lower side supports.

The sunflower tiles were stocked by **Barnard Bishop & Barnard**, for whom **Thomas Jeckyll** designed Anglo-Japanese decorative cast iron furniture and Anglo-Japanese fire grates for.
